Country-style Barbecue Ribs
Meaty ribs are first simmered, then cooked over coals for that good barbecue flavor—
 4 pounds country-style ribs, cut in serving-size pieces

- 1 tablespoon butter or margarine
- 1 clove garlic, crushed
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup catsup
- $\frac{1}{3}$ cup chili sauce
- 2 tablespoons brown sugar
- 2 tablespoons chopped onion
- 1 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce
- 1 tablespoon prepared mustard
- 1 teaspoon celery seed
- $\frac{1}{4}$ teaspoon salt
- Dash bottled hot pepper sauce
- 3 thin lemon slices

Simmer ribs, covered, in salted water to cover till nearly tender, about 1 hour. Meanwhile, prepare barbecue sauce: In saucepan, melt butter or margarine; add garlic and cook 4 to 5 minutes. Add remaining ingredients; bring to boiling. Drain ribs; grill over medium coals about 10 minutes on each side*, brushing with sauce till well coated. Makes 6 to 8 servings.
 *If ribs are chilled before grilling, cook 15 to 18 minutes on each side.
