To where it bent in the undergrowth;*

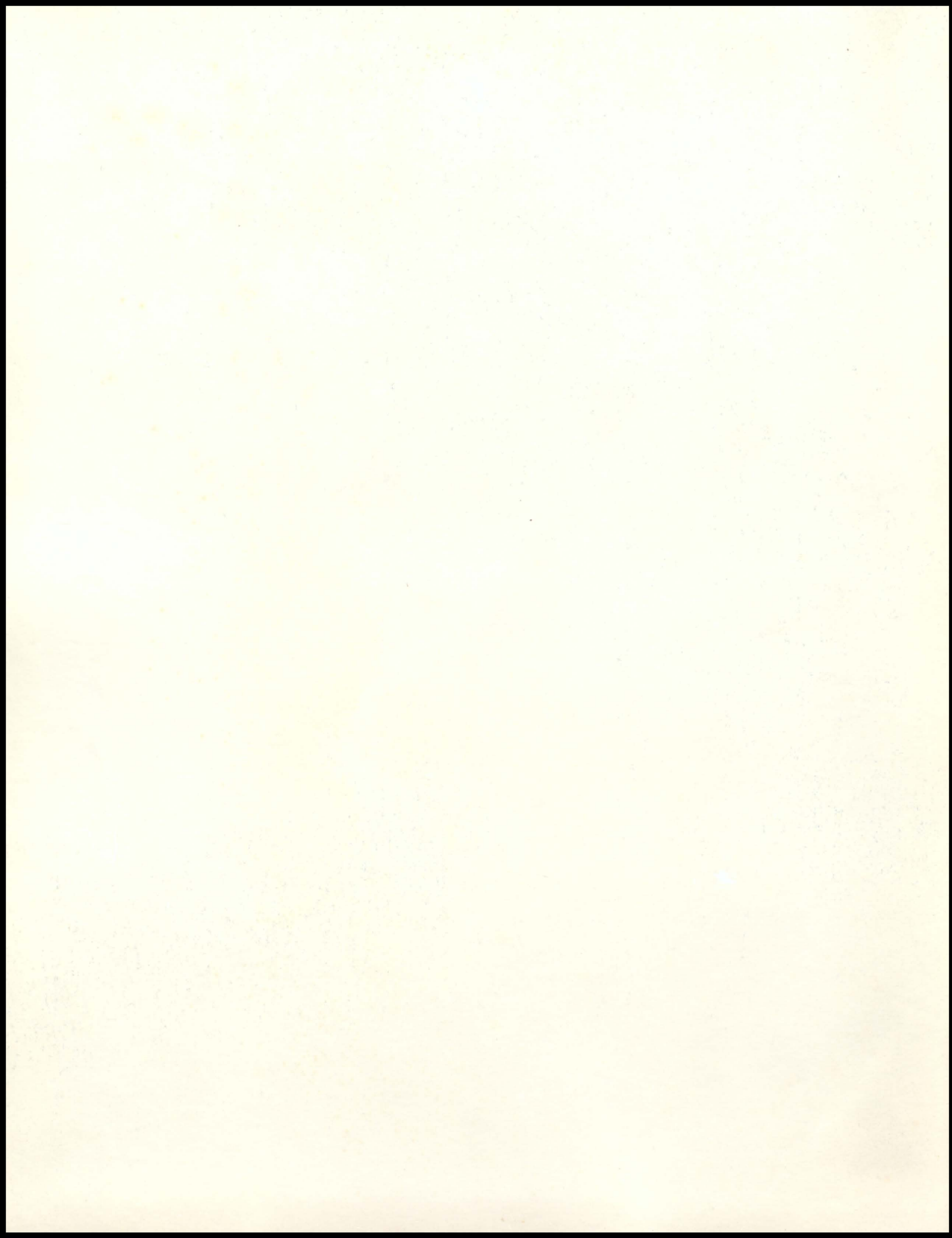
*Then took the other, as just as fair,

And that has made all the difference,*

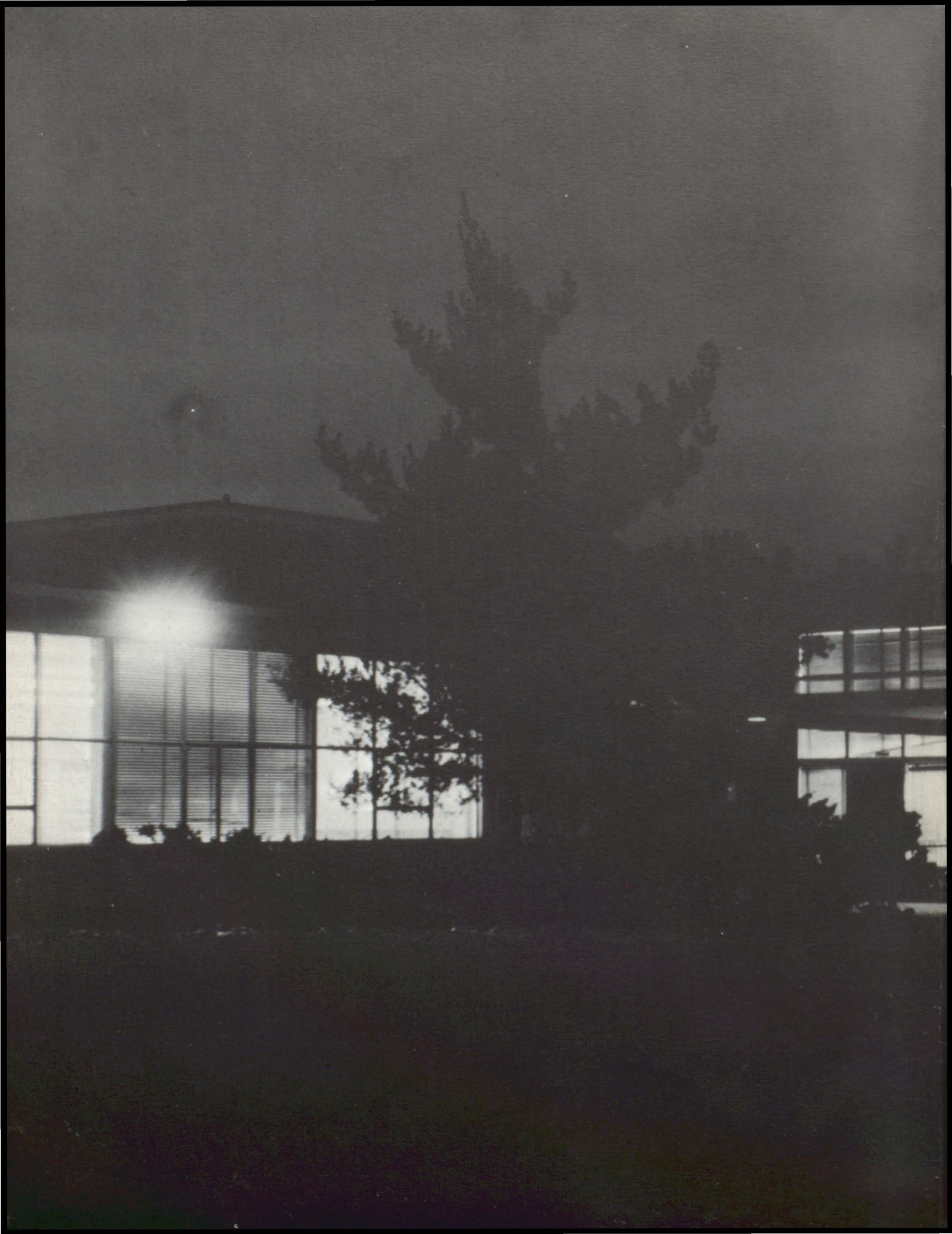






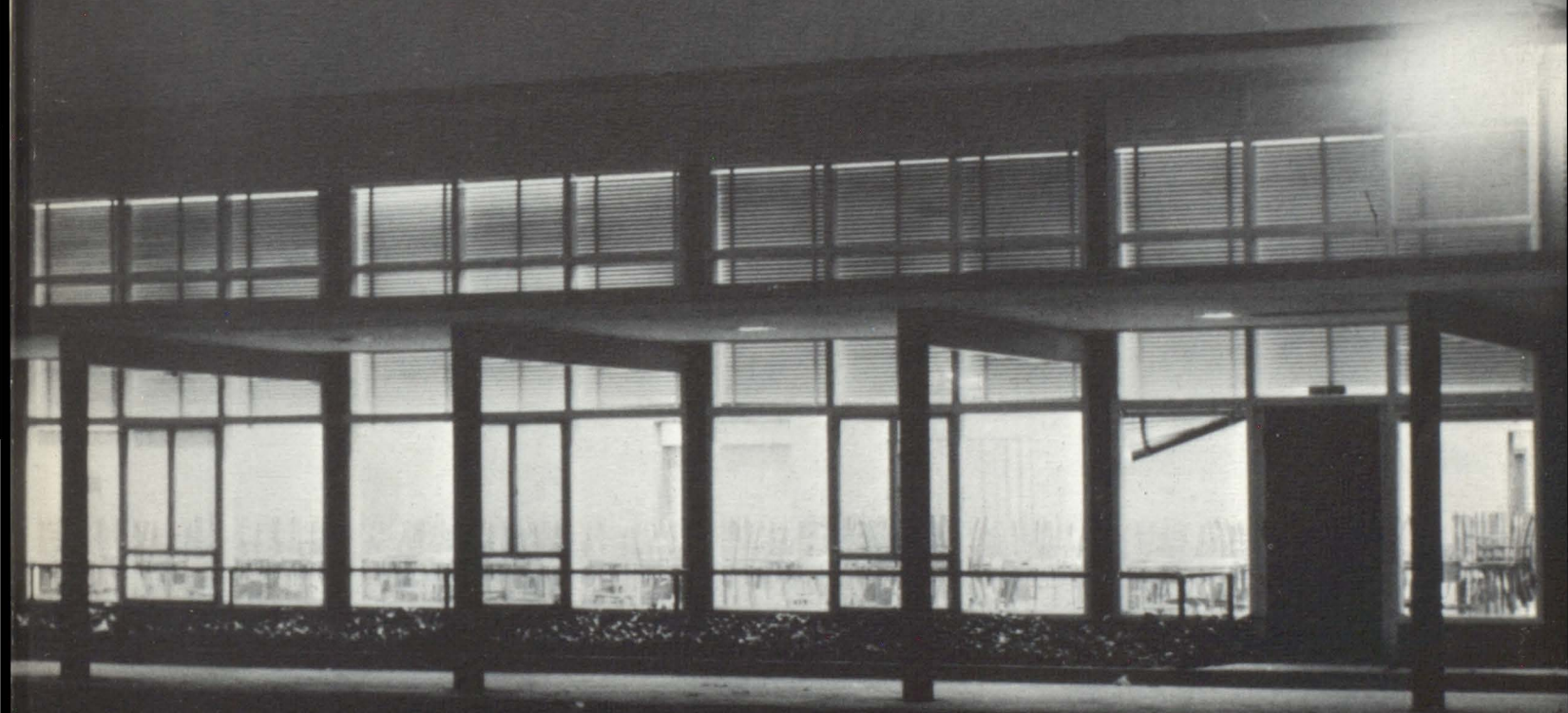
